Health and Safety at Work Act 1974

It is a Health and Safety requirement that this form be completed when any handling of equipment is required, where the equipment has been in contact with any Hazardous Biological, Chemical or Radioactive materials.

This form should accompany the ExServices Returned Goods Form, and is a declaration that the equipment has been decontaminated, and is safe for Exheat workshop personnel or other contractors to work on. In some cases even when the equipment has not been exposed to any Hazardous materials, a negative return is required for equipment that is being sent for rework/repair.
